The Minister of Public Health, Dr MANAOUDA Malachie, hereby informs the national opinion that three (03) young Cameroonians, suffering from chronic kidney failure, have just benefited from successful kidney transplants, conducted by a team of health professionals at the Yaounde General Hospital.

The three kidney transplant surgeries were carried out between 31 January and 2 February 2023, on patients aged 25, 28 and 33 years respectively. The donors were all family members of the recipients.

These major achievements which are recorded in our health facilities, and in this case, at the Yaounde General Hospital, are the result of the progressive and continuous upgrading of the infrastructure and the technical platform, as well as the very high qualification of our health personnel, as recently pointed out by the President of the Republic, His Excellency Paul BIYA in his address to the Nation, on 31 December 2022.

The Minister of Public Health once again takes this opportunity to congratulate the team of the Yaounde General Hospital, who achieved this exploit, and to encourage the "health soldiers" who do not spare their expertise to relieve the sufferings of our populations and thus contribute to the improvement of their well-being.

Dr MANAOUDA Malachie, therefore, encourages patients to trust their health system, which is gradually being modernised, for a better implementation of the Universal Health Coverage that is being set up.
