

RADIO-PRESS RELEASE

The Minister of Public Health, **Dr MANAOUDA Malachie**, hereby informs the public in general and medical doctors in particular, that in accordance with the provisions of Article 32 of Decree No. 92-265-PM of 22 July 1992 establishing the modalities for the application of Law No. 90-26 of 10 August 1990 on the practice and organisation of the medical profession an Extraordinary General Assembly shall be held on **Wednesday, 18 January 2023**, at 8 a.m. prompt, at the Yaounde Conference Centre, exclusively devoted to the election of members of the Cameroon Medical Council.

This election, which will take into account all the applications registered for the General Assembly of 29 December 2022, is opened to all medical doctors who are registered with the Cameroon Medical Council.

In this regard, the Minister indicates that the provisional electoral list, which is available online on the website of the Ministry of Public Health at www.minsante.cm, can be accessed by any person concerned by this election.

At the same time, in order to guarantee the greatest fairness and transparency of the election, any person who feels wronged by the omission of their name or by any error in their information is invited to submit their application, with the supporting documents attesting to their status as a medical practitioner duly registered on the list of the medical council, on the platform dedicated to this concern at the address <http://elections-onmc.cm>. These applications will be accepted until Thursday 05 January 2023 at 6pm.

He also invites the candidates to the election to take part or to be represented at the session to clean up and validate the final electoral list which will be held on Friday **06 January 2023** from 9 a.m. in the conference room of the Ministry of Public Health.

Dr MANAOUDA Malachie recalls that the organisation of this Extraordinary General Assembly, which aims at providing the Cameroon Medical Council with functional and strong organs, is a duty of every medical doctor. He therefore counts on the sense of duty, discipline and responsibility of everyone, for a massive mobilization in transparency, serenity and respect for republican institutions, to actively take part in this work to build a viable and relevant professional Order as a privileged interlocutor of the Government on issues pertaining to the medical profession in Cameroon. /-
