On behalf of the Minister of Public Health, Dr. MANAOUDA Malachie, I would like to welcome you at the Public Health Emergency Operations Centre for our daily press briefing.

The evolution of COVID-19 pandemic in our country continues to be of concern as we see its progression. However, we are working hard to stop the spread of this disease as much as possible, particularly in communities. Rural areas are our focus. Furthermore, we reassure the populations that community actions take place without major difficulties because the sensitized populations are receptive to the Government measures. This proves that we will win the fight against Coronavirus faster.

We will continue to encourage and congratulate all those who are working tirelessly day and night to save lives and improve the pandemic management system. We also welcome the results of the decentralization process that is taking off.

To date, the epidemiological situation reports ... recoveries and ... deaths. We would like to remind the populations that COVID-19 patients are managed free of charge regardless their social status.

We call on the populations, especially those who are still sceptical that Coronavirus disease exists and that it makes no distinction when it must rage. - covering your nose and mouth with a disposable tissue when coughing, sneezing or using a bent elbow;
- avoiding close contact with anyone with flu symptoms;
- maintaining social distancing of at least 1.5 metres.
